

TOPIC: 1-2-3 DISCIPLESHIP

CONFESSION-What do you need to confess?

LEARNING-What are you learning?

ACCOUNTABILITY-How can we hold you accountable this week?

PRAYER & PRAISE-How can we pray for you? What are you praising God for?

1 COR 11:1 It's okay to want to emulate someone who emulates Jesus. Who are some people in Scripture that you want to imitate? Discuss their character, traits, and habits.

Below are just a few examples:

- Paul: Bold and humble- Rom 1:16; 1 Cor 2:1-5; Rom 15:17-21
- Timothy: Young and faithful-1 Tim 4:12
- Barnabas: Encouraging- Acts 9:26-27
- Priscilla and Aquilla: Faithful workers- Acts 18:26; Rom 16:3-5

Our work isn't done until new believers become disciple makers. Discuss Eph 4:12-13.

3 EXAMPLES TO FOLLOW.

2 Tim 2:3-6. Discuss how you plan to practice these attributes in your daily life.

- Soldier- disciplined
- Athlete-train hard
- Farmer- work hard and be patient
